

Protocol of the Annual Meeting of PGS Rheology Group on October 12, 1999, at ETH Zurich

For the annual meeting 12 members of the Rheology Group were present, in addition to the executive committee which consisted of Dr. D. Hajdistamov, Dr. A. Luciani and Prof. E.J. Windhab. Prof. H.C. Oettinger was excused.

- E. Windhab welcomed the attendees and presented the agenda for the meeting:

The reporting on the activities in 1999 was done by E. Windhab and A. Luciani. The Spring '99 meeting at Nestlé Research Centre in Lausanne with over 100 participants and an excellent scientific program was a full success. E. Windhab thanked A. Luciani and Dr. Ian Roberts of Nestlé again for the proficient organisation of this event.

Also, this fall meeting, which ended just before the annual meeting of the Rheology Group, was successful with approx. 40 participants and a high-quality program of scientific presentations and posters.

E. Windhab informed that in 1999 the Italian colleagues received their membership in the European Society of Rheology.

The financial report for the period 10/98 to 10/99 shows a positive development due to the high numbers of participants of the Spring '99 meeting in Lausanne. The total income in these 12 months amounted up to Sfr. 3'536,60. Total expenditures of Sfr. 2'768,85 occurred in the same time period, which leaves a positive balance of Sfr. 767,75. Thus the total amount of funds available now to the Rheology Group is Sfr. 4'812,80.

The British Society of Rheology informs that their bulleting will now be published three times/year (i.e. 4/15, 8/15, 12/15). The annual subscription fee for national rheological societies has been raised to £5.00 per member.

If the national rheological societies are interested in a subscription under the newly announced conditions, £5.00 per registered member have to be paid in advance.

As an alternative the bulletin can be downloaded electronically and copies for members can be printed as needed. The clear majority of the members voted for ordering the bulletin from the British Society of Rheology.

c) 20 – 25/8/2000	Eighth International Congress on Rheology Cambridge, UK
